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Contract (written)—five years, § 5-216

Contract (oral)—four years, § 5-217

Sale of goods—four years, § 28-275

Action to foreclose a real property mortgage—five years from the maturity date of the obligation or indebtedness secured by such mortgage and where the mortgage does not provide for a maturity date, “then the date of the accrual of the cause of action giving rise to the right to foreclose,” § 5-214A

### **Borrowing Statute**

§ 5-239

When a cause of action has arisen in another state or territory, or in a foreign country, and by the laws thereof an action thereon cannot there be maintained against a person by reason of the lapse of time, an action thereon shall not be maintained against him in this state, except in favor of one who has been a citizen of this state and who has held the cause of action from the time it accrued.
